

Documents needed for Veterans Aid & Attendance Special Pension

- ☐ Copy of Military Discharge/Separation Papers (DD-214)
- ☐ Copy of Marriage Certificate (Surviving Spouses only)
- ☐ Copy of the Death Certificate (Surviving Spouses only)
- ☐ Copy of 2024 Social Security Benefits Letter (the letter that Social Security sends at the end of each year stating what your monthly amount will be for the following year.)
- ☐ Documentation of all income, Pensions or Retirement, Interest income from investments, annuities, rental income etc.
- ☐ Asset documents including: Bank Accounts, Checking & Savings, CDs, Trusts, Mutual Funds, Stocks, Bonds, Annuities, etc. (ALL PAGES)
- ☐ 1099's from previous year taxes

The Aid & Attendance Pension was established in 1952 to provide financial assistance to wartime veterans and/ or their surviving spouses, who lack the funds necessary to pay for the care they require with routine activities of daily living such as, medication management, dressing, mobility, meal preparation, bathing, etc.

Care can be provided at Home, Independent Living, Assisted Living or Skilled Nursing Home by relatives or professional staff.

If you served our country during a period of war you may be eligible for this pension.

By accessing this pension, you will be able to increase your dollars available to pay for care or move into the type of facility where you can receive the services you need. This pension is received monthly and is paid directly into the veterans or surviving spouses bank account.

PERIODS OF WAR

- World War II:
December 7, 1941
through December
31, 1946
- Korean Conflict:
June 27, 1950, through
January 31, 1955.
- Vietnam Era:
November 1, 1955
through August 5, 1964
for Veterans who served
in Vietnam. August 5,
1964 through May 7, 1975
for Veterans who served
outside of Vietnam.
- Gulf War:
August 2, 1990 through
a date to be determined
by law.
- Must have served 90 days
active duty with one day
during a period of war,
and honorably discharged.
